

**AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE  
NAVAJO NATION AND THE CITY OF GALLUP  
REGARDING PASS-THROUGH OF FEDERAL APPROPRIATIONS  
FOR OPERATION OF THE  
GALLUP ALCOHOL CRISIS CENTER**

**WHEREAS** the City of Gallup is a political subdivision of the State of New Mexico and has authority to enter into this agreement, and;

**WHEREAS** the Navajo Nation is a sovereign Indian nation and has authority to enter into this agreement, and;

**WHEREAS** a cooperative effort between the City of Gallup, the Navajo Nation, McKinley County and the Zuni Pueblo of Indians resulted in the appropriation of \$895,400.00 by the United States Congress pursuant to P.L. 100-690 for first year operating funds for the Gallup Alcohol Crisis Center ("Center"), and;


**WHEREAS** the City of Gallup, the Navajo Nation, McKinley County and the Zuni Pueblo of Indians jointly created a Board of Directors to govern the Center with certain powers as specified in the Articles of Agreement ( Exhibit "A"), and;


**WHEREAS** Article II (4) of the agreement provides that funds for construction and operation of the Center shall be handled by the City of Gallup as fiscal agent, and shall be subject to the audit procedures for which the City of Gallup is responsible.

**IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. *Purpose* -- The purpose of this Agreement is to provide for cooperation in passing-through Federal appropriations for operation of the Center. The Center shall provide short-term basic shelter, humane care and referral to treatment or other services for persons (mostly Navajo) deemed to be intoxicated in public within the City of Gallup.
2. *Effective Date* -- This Agreement shall become effective upon signature by both parties and continue, as necessary, to pass-through future Federal appropriations to operate the Center.
3. *Pass-through Procedures* -- Within thirty (30) days after notice of grant award, the Navajo Nation shall deposit a lump sum amount equal to the entire Federal appropriation in the account established by the Fiscal Agent (i.e., City of Gallup) to operate the Center. On or before September 30, 1991 the first year appropriation of eight hundred ninety five thousand four hundred and no/100 (\$895,400) dollars shall be deposited in the Center's account.
4. *Annual Audit* -- The Fiscal Agent will provide the Navajo Nation with a copy of the independent certified audit required by the State of New Mexico within thirty (30) days after acceptance and approval by the State Auditor.
5. *Assurances* -- The Fiscal Agent agrees to comply with the Federal assurances for non-construction programs (Exhibit "B") and the U. S. Public Health Service certification regarding lobbying (Exhibit "C").
6. *Modification* -- This Agreement may be modified only by written amendment signed by duly authorized officials representing both parties.
