

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLIENTS ENTERING INPATIENT TREATMENT

All referred clients must have items 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, & 6 prior to admissions into the Treatment Program.

1. Must have proof of guarantor/Payer for the cost of treatment with Name and Address for verification and payment and admission letter.
2. Must have recent medical history exam and medical summary of their status including diagnosis, medication, if no medication must have five days of medication and prognosis of their illness by the primary physician.
3. Any current medical/dental problems must be treated prior to admission.
4. Legal status includes the nature of the offense, type of violation, and Probation guidelines.
- 5. Must have PPD records/current with in the last three months or chest x-rays within the last 2 years.
6. Must complete the ASI by license counselor/mental health provider.

Items 7, and 8 must accompany the client.

7. Four (4) sets of clothing; modest clothing is to be worn at all times.
8. Pair of tennis shoes, sweat pants, and shirts. (Sports trunk for sweat lodge)
9. You are allowed to bring a blanket and pillow to may your stay comfortable.
10. You may provide your own hygiene articles: tooth paste, tooth brush, shampoo, shaving cream, and personal grooming items such as comb, hair brush, towels and wash cloths. No alcohol based articles, please.
11. Shower Slippers for showers.
12. Bring a Notebook, Pen, Pencils, Pocket Folder.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED

1. No televisions
2. No non-prescription medication, such as personal vitamins.
3. No short skirts, sleeveless t-shirts, gang related, and imprinted clothing.
4. No alcohol based mouthwash and hairspray.
5. No cell phone, cassette players, walkmans, I Pod, and headsets and electronic devices.

MONEY

Clients are allowed to keep up to \$5.00 (in quarters) in their possession during treatment. The facility does not have funds to make change for the vending machines.
