What to bring when entering HBS inpatient residential treatment:

All referred relatives must have items #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6, and #7 3 days prior to admission to the Eagle Plume Society program.

1. Relatives must have a **letter of interest** written, stating why they would like to join the HBS program and receive treatment.
2. Relatives must have most **recent medical history exam** including medications (medications: must have sixty (60) days of medication).
3. **A legal report which includes**, nature of offense(s), type of violation and probation guidelines. (Judgment and Sentence)
4. **PPD records** (current within the last six (6) months or chest x-ray within last two (2) years).
5. Relatives must have **Initial Intake** and **Intake Questioner** Forms filled out by their referring agency.
6. **Alcohol Severity Index**, within the past 3 months, will also need to be provided by referring agency.
7. If Relative is on Probation, we will need **a letter from the probation officer stating** his/her client will not be required to report to their Probation Officer, while receiving treatment. (This includes Phone Calls, Visits and any requests for UA or Blood Test)

Items #8, #9, #10, #11, and #12 must accompany the relative:

8. Bring five (5) sets of clothing. Modest clothing is worn at all times. Mark your clothes before you enter the program.
9. Bring a pair of tennis shoes, sweat pants and t-shirts. T-shirt cannot display gang related emblems nor alcohol emblems.
10. Bring your own toiletries: toothpaste, tooth brush, shampoo, shaving cream and personal grooming items (comb, brush).
11. Relatives are allowed to keep up to \$5.00 (in quarters) in their possession during treatment.
12. Relative will also need to bring a blanket, Pillow, writing paper, envelopes and pens or pencils.

**NO ALCOHOL-BASED ARTICLES IS ALLOWED.**

Not permitted are: **NO ELECTRONICS** (Radios, IPods, Cell Phones, CD Players, MP3 Players, etc.)  
**NO NON-PERSCRIPTION MEDICATION** (Diet Pills, Tylenol, Motrin, ibuprofen, etc.)  
**NO ALCOHOL-BASED MOUTH WASH, HAIR SPRAY OR MEDICATION**
